FINISHED SIZES

Soda-Can Cozy: fits 12-oz can

Water-Bottle Cozy: fits 16.9-oz bottle

MATERIALS

- Peaches & Creme bulky (chunky) weight yarn (4 oz/100 yds/85g per ball):



1 ball #177 Aztec
(soda-can cozy)

- Peaches & Creme medium (worsted) weight yarn (2 oz/98 yds per ball):



1 ball #186 lemon lime
(water-bottle cozy)

- Size I/9/5.5mm and J/10/6mm crochet hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- 1-inch metal D-ring
- Carabiner hook
- Regular-size plastic grocery bags: 6 tan, 8 white
- Craft scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Ruler
- Stitch marker

GAUGE

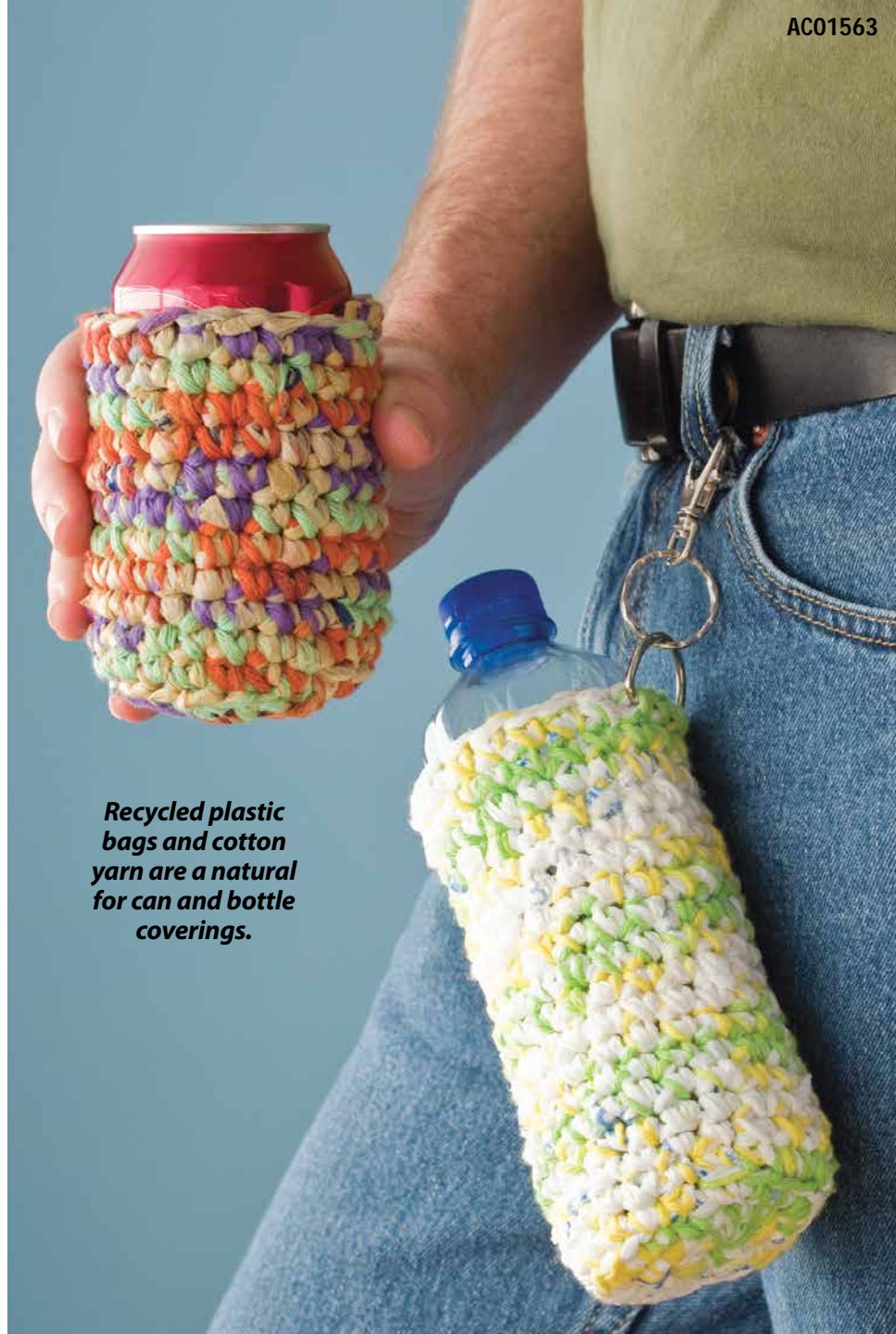
Size I hook: bottom rnds 1–3 = 1½ inches; 5 sc = 2 inches

Size J hook: bottom rnds 1–3 = 1¾ inches; 4 sc = 1½ inches

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise stated.



Recycled plastic bags and cotton yarn are a natural for can and bottle coverings.

PLASTIC BAG PREPARATION

Place one bag flat on work surface, smooth and fold bag in half lengthwise, smooth and fold lengthwise again. Bag is now approximately 2¾ inches wide. Use craft scissors to trim off handles and bottom seam. Repeat with remaining bags.

Stack several folded bags tog on cutting mat; with rotary cutter, cut 1-inch-wide strips. Repeat with remaining bags.

SODA-CAN COZY

Rnd 1: With size J hook and 1 strand each tan plastic and Aztec held tog, ch 4, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join in beg sc. (8 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, join in first sc. (16 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times, sc in last sc, **do not join**,

use stitch marker to mark rnds for rem of Cozy. (21 sc)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*) for this rnd only, sc in each st around.

Rnds 5–13: Sc in each sc around

Rnd 14: Sc in each sc around, sl st in next sc. Fasten off.

WATER-BOTTLE COZY

Rnd 1: With size I hook and 1 strand each white plastic and lemon lime held tog, ch 4, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join in beg sc. (8 sc)

Rnds 2–4: Rep rnds 2–4 of Soda-Can Cozy. (21 sc)

Rnd 5–20: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 21: Place flat edge of D-ring along top edge of rnd 20, sc over flat edge for 3 or 4 sc, sc in each rem sc around, sl st in next sc. Fasten off.

Attach carabiner hook to D-ring. Use carabiner hook to attach Water-Bottle Cozy to belt lp. **CW**

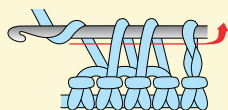

Single crochet decrease (sc dec):

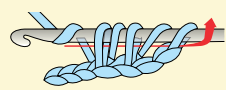
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):

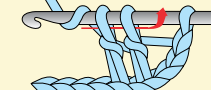
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

Double crochet decrease (dc dec):

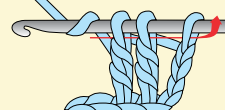
Yo, insert hook, yo, draw loop through, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



Example of 2-dc dec

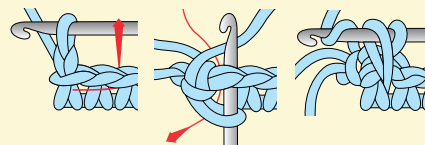
Treble crochet decrease (tr dec):

Hold-ing back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

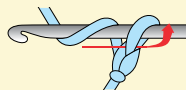


Example of 2-tr dec

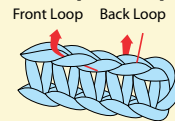
Reverse Single Crochet (reverse sc): Ch 1. Skip first st. [Working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo, and draw through both lps on hook.]



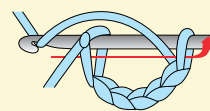
Chain (ch): Yo, pull through lp on hook.



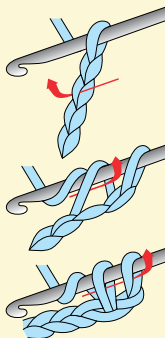
Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)



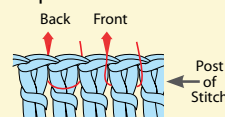
Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



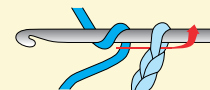
Single crochet (sc): Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



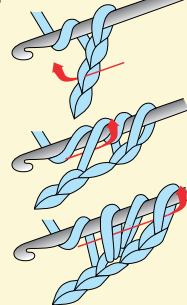
Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post st on previous row.



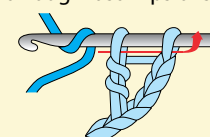
Chain Color Change (ch color change) Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



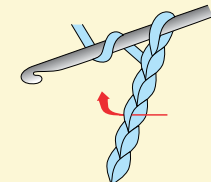
Half double crochet (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



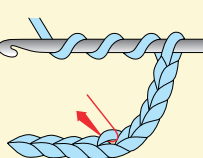
Double Crochet Color Change (dc color change) Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



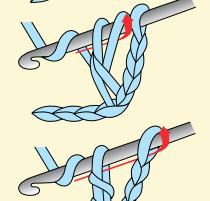
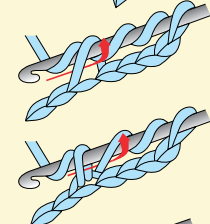
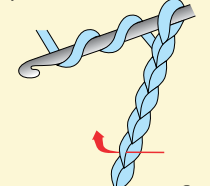
Double crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



Treble crochet (tr): Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.



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
